President of Global Venue Development, Oak View Group

Steve Collins is the President of Global Venue Development for Oak View Group, where he leads the team responsible for designing, developing and constructing the company's owned and operated venues. Steve joined OVG in 2019 and has overseen the deployment of over \$5B of capital creating Oak View Group's marquee portfolio of venues, including Climate Pledge Arena, UBS Arena, Moody Center, Acrisure Arena, CFG Bank Arena and Co-op Live Arena in Manchester, UK, as well as the ongoing renovation of the FirstOntario Centre in Canada.

Collins has over 30 years of experience in sports and entertainment venue design, construction and operations. Prior to joining OVG, he was the Chief Operating Officer of the Golden State Warriors where he was responsible for the 11-acre mixed use development in San Francisco anchored by the 18,000 seat Chase Center arena. Collins was responsible for the design, construction, and operation of the multibillion-dollar development which also included two office towers and a 100,000 sq. ft. restaurant and retail district.

Prior to the Golden State Warriors, Collins was the Executive Vice President of the Facilities Division of Madison Square Garden where he was responsible for overseeing the operations of all MSG properties including Madison Square Garden Arena, Radio City Music Hall, the Los Angeles Forum, the Beacon Theater and the Chicago Theater. During his 12 years at MSG Collins also managed the \$1 billion renovation of Madison Square Garden arena, as well as the \$120 million renovation of the Los Angeles Forum.

After graduating from Gettysburg College, Steve began his career at the New Jersey Sport and Exposition Authority where he spent 10 years in a variety of positions in building and event operations at both the Meadowlands Arena and Giants Stadium.
